
BIO-BENIN COMING OF AGE AND PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE



Dear Loyal Donors to Bio-Benin,

With so much bad news around the world and a retreat from caring about those less fortunate, I'm happy to report that thanks to your generosity, 30 more underprivileged youth in Benin are now fully employed and earning a living wage using the cooking skills they learned Chez Guillaume.

In January we will launch our new craft beer brewing program, with 10 new apprentices to start. All are local, from poor families, with almost no hope of gaining good employment without the training they receive through Bio-Benin.



We're truly coming of age, establishing a more stable foundation that will endure.

In Benin, we now have a local office with a secretary and are searching for an Executive Director to guide our efforts, potentially a woman to focus more attention on women's needs. Our Treasurer, Philippe Owa, is keeping a close check on all expenditures.

In Canada we're applying for charitable status so that Canadian donors will get the tax deductions they deserve, hence the new logo.

Young volunteers are helping with technology, social media and publicity. We recruited two new Board members, one as Treasurer, the other, based in France, to expand our reach. Margaret has already visited the farm and restaurant in Natitingou and planted trees along the waterways! She's a great asset. Walter has worked Chez Guillaume and is a whiz at Excel spreadsheets!
